Please find below information regarding your entry to **Metropolitan France**:

Effective from 9 June, the movement of travelers between France and foreign countries will resume under terms and conditions that will vary according to the health status of these countries and the vaccination status of travelers. The vaccination schedule is considered complete 28 days after the administration of a dose for Janssen vaccine and 7 days after administration of a second dose for other vaccines (Pfizer / Comirnaty, Moderna, AstraZeneca / Vaxzevria/Covishield).

To deal with the virus and contain the introduction of its variants, border control measures are temporarily needed, both on entering and leaving the country. Accordingly, countries have been classified based on health indicators. The lists of countries may be updated as the epidemic situation evolves, and applicable rules depend on the travelers' vaccination status.

The country color code has been used to reflect the information available on the [French Ministry of Interior](#), and please find here below the summary of this situation to date with 3 main categories:

- Group 1 – Travelling from a “green list” country**



These requirements are re-assessed regularly by the French authorities, and we will update you should there be a change before the General Assembly.

All foreign travellers must present a valid passport at the border as well as the usually required documents: proof of resources and accommodation, and [a short stay visa if applicable to their nationality](#). Before arrival, the FIA will provide you in addition to the mention documents above a letter from the FIA with the emphasis on the compulsory notion of participation to the General Assembly to facilitate the obtention of your visas and entry to metropolitan France.
