EU SUPPORTS EMPLOYMENT OPPORTUNITIES AND ACTIVE CITIZENSHIP OF YOUNG PEOPLE IN EASTERN PARTNER COUNTRIES

A YOUTH AND EDUCATION PACKAGE TO DELIVER CHANGE BY 2020 AND BEYOND

Improving prospects for youth is at the heart of cooperation within the Eastern Partnership. Together with the six partner countries, the European Union aims to create further opportunities for young people to study, work, participate fully in society and fulfil their potential.

Across the Eastern Partnership, the European Union is providing close to €330 million of support to youth under its Youth and Education Package for 2017-2020.

Support for youth will remain at the centre of the Eastern Partnership policy beyond 2020.



EDUCATION, TRAINING AND MOBILITY

Erasmus+: €210 million for the EaP region for 2014-2020, enabling over 80,000 young people, youth workers, students and academic staff to benefit from exchange opportunities, including:

- Scholarships to study in Europe
- Student exchanges
- European Solidarity Corps
- Youth exchanges

Higher education reform: close to €65 million in EU bilateral support for 2017-2020 contributing to the modernisation and quality assurance of the education system.

eTwinning Plus: By 2020, over 3,000 schools from across the EaP are connected via eTwinning Plus and over 7,700 teachers are engaged in exchanges and professional development.

European School in Georgia: launched in September 2018, a beacon of excellence for pupils from the EaP region who will receive an internationally recognised degree. With the second cohort of pupils having taken up studies in September 2019, 65 young people receive a high quality multilingual and multicultural education including an understanding of the EU, its core values, and the FaP



EMPLOYMENT AND ENTREPRENEURSHIP

EU4Youth: €43 million in EU support for the EaP region to foster entrepreneurial potential and develop labour market skills, through the establishment of business incubators and innovation clusters, mentoring schemes focused on entrepreneurship, including social entrepreneurship, and non-formal catchup programmes for early school leavers.

Ten large grants were launched in 2017-2019 to support employability and entrepreneurship among disadvantaged youth, and 267 organisations from the Eastern partner countries participate in EU4Youth capacity building small grants projects.

Vocational Education and Training (VET): close to €85 million in EU bilateral support for 2017-2020 to improve skills, boost private sector involvement in VET, modernise qualifications and make VET more attractive for young people.

European Training Foundation: supporting cooperation by mapping of policies supporting young people in their transition to work, to identify priority areas for action and to support national youth strategies.



PARTICIPATION AND LEADERSHIP

The 4th Eastern Partnership Youth Forum of June 2019 discussed 'Critical thinking through media literacy and active participation'.

EaP Civil Society Fellowship Programme: supporting young civil society leaders from Eastern partner countries in developing leadership and skills – **80 fellows from the EaP region** were selected in 2017-2020.

EU4Youth **Civil Society Fellowships for Youth**: supporting youth organisations and about 460 fellows in becoming active participants in policy-development.

Young European Ambassadors: nearly 700 'Young European Ambassadors' (YEAs) are fostering cooperation between young people and youth organisations in the EU and the Eastern partner countries, as part of the 'EU NEIGHBOURS east' project.

European Solidarity Corps: since 2018 open to young people from neighbouring countries, aged 18-30.

SUPPORT TO YOUTH ACROSS DIFFERENT SECTORS

The **EU4Business**, **EU4Innovation** and **EU4Digital** initiatives support, amongst others, young people in entrepreneurship, innovation and digital fields.

Coming soon: support for young creative talent in the cultural sector through EU4Culture.
