Sustainability in the Black Sea regional cooperation: Advancing the Black Sea Synergy and the European Green Deal

Cross-border Cooperation and Connecting with the Danube

This thematic session will focus on 'Cross-border Cooperation and Connecting with the Danube' and is organised by DG REGIO. Four EU-funded projects related to this theme in connection with the Green Deal will be presented. More specifically, the session will discuss issues related to the reduction of river and marine litter, monitoring data, interdisciplinary research, and natural habitat in the Black Sea and Danube region. Speakers and presenters will address various questions, such as: What are the project objectives and what are the results achieved? What is the added value of cooperation in the project? What are the synergies with the relevant regional cooperation frameworks and/or similar/complementary initiatives? Following these initial brief presentations, a debate will be opened with the wider audience, with a question/answer session and a forward-looking discussion.
