Role of EU Delegations (Please note Erasmus+ is not managed by EU Delegations)

- Disseminate information about opportunities offered by Erasmus+
- Regarding mobility programmes, organize pre departure events for grantees of scholarships and if possible in partnership with EMA
- Contact with national authorities and National Focal Point
- Make assessments regarding shortlisted proposals
- Represent EU in project meetings when invited
- Provide guidance regarding EU procedures in general (for contractual issues refer to operational manager in headquarters)

Erasmus+ Promotion Activities

- Study in Europe and other education events organized by EUMS agencies
- Participate in events and meetings organized by CBHE projects when possible
- Participate in meetings organized by HEIs when possible Disseminate information about Erasmus+ opportunities using Delegation
- webpage and social media
- Respond to requests for information from HEIs and other stakeholders

Award Criteria – Consultations with Delegations

- Recognition of HEIs by the national competent authorities.
- Feasibility of the project in the local context.
- The project is contributing to the needs in the priority area.
- Overlapping with existing initiatives in the chosen thematic area funded by the EU Delegation, national or international donors.

- Green transition
- Digital transformation
- Democratic governance, security and migration
- Inclusive and Sustainable Economic Recovery Social cohesion and fight against inequalities ERASMUS+: mobility and innovation
