Role of EU Delegations

(Please note Erasmus+ is not managed by EU Delegations)

- Disseminate information about opportunities offered by Erasmus+
- Regarding mobility programmes, organize pre departure events for grantees of scholarships and if possible in partnership with EMA
- Contact with national authorities and National Focal Point
- Make assessments regarding shortlisted proposals
- Represent EU in project meetings when invited
- Provide guidance regarding EU procedures in general (for contractual issues refer to operational manager in headquarters)

Erasmus+ Promotion Activities

- Study in Europe and other education events organized by EUMS agencies
 - Participate in events and meetings organized by CBHE projects when possible
 - Participate in meetings organized by HEIs when possible
 - Disseminate information about Erasmus+ opportunities using Delegation webpage and social media
 - Respond to requests for information from HEIs and other stakeholders

Award Criteria – Consultations with Delegations

- Recognition of HEIs by the national competent authorities.
- Feasibility of the project in the local context.
- The project is contributing to the needs in the priority area.
- Overlapping with existing initiatives in the chosen thematic area funded by the EU Delegation, national or international donors.



Coordination with other EU funded activities in the region (priorities MIP Americas)

- Green transition
- Digital transformation
- Inclusive and Sustainable Economic Recovery
- Democratic governance, security and migration
- Social cohesion and fight against inequalities
- ERASMUS+: mobility and innovation



Erasmus+

Youth Sounding Board (EU Delegation Brazil) – advisory group with objective to include youth in cooperation activities and give them a voice. Young people in general are very interested about Erasmus+, particularly about mobility programmes but also CBHE.

EUNIC (for example the EU Delegation has been invited to speak about Erasmus during 9 of May events organized by EU MS cultural institutes).

For CBHE – very important to inform EU Delegations about events in partner countries.

Capacity Building Projects Erasmus+

- Promote synergies with other EU funded projects
- Interactions with Erasmus+ focal point at the EU Delegations and also with National Focal Points (coordinator and partners)
