What is the Export Support Service?

- The Export Support Service is a government service run by the Department for International Trade (DIT).
- This online digital service is your first point of contact to get answers to questions about exporting your products or services to customers in Europe, Eastern Europe and Central Asia.
- Businesses can submit an online form to the service and a **call-back** facility is available for those who wish to speak to someone about their enquiry.
- It can also help you navigate other government services so you can find further support about trading with Europe and other markets, such as DIT's International Trade Advisers and the Export Academy.
- The Export Support Service will expand to cover all global markets by April 2023.







• Any UK based business that is exporting or considering exporting. Everyone is eligible: no matter the size of your business, how much you export or where in the UK you are based.

Is it a free service?

• Yes, the service is completely free for UK businesses.

What sort of questions can be asked?

- The service can provide **information and guidance** for questions about exporting. It can also help customers navigate the guidance on **GOV.UK and other support services.**
- The Export Support Service manages various questions on topics including rules of origin, guidance on recognising professional qualifications, entering new markets and supports services and goods businesses.

Why do you provide this service?

- DIT launched the Export Support Service so UK businesses can get answers to questions about exporting. It
 offers cross government information and support all in one place.
- We have listened to businesses and streamlined government support to make it easier for exporters to access the information they need at every stage of their exporting journey.












How does the online form work?
