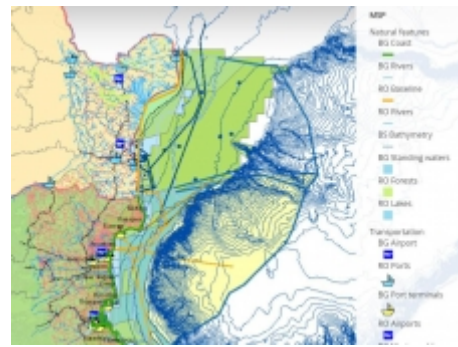

New strategic guidelines for EU aquaculture

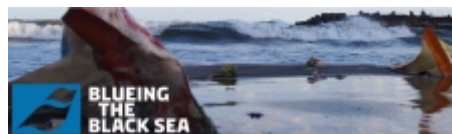
