Sherborne Wharf Canal Boat Tour



Duration: Two hours

The tour will depart from the International Convention Centre (The ICC) and proceed towards Sherborne Wharf Marina, here you will pass the Sea Life Centre Birmingham and Symphony Hall. Your boat will then pass through the Marina heading towards Oozells Loop via the main line, continuing up to Hockey Port Loop. The tour will then take you past Edgbaston Reservoir and back through the city passing the newly refurbished Round House and the Distillery Pub, formerly the Fiddle and Bone, where live music was played under the tunnels every weekend.

Proceeding on your journey, your boat will take you pass the Utilita Arena Birmingham and by the Symphony Hall and the ICC where you will enter Gas Street Basin, cruising through the narrows and passing the Old Toll House - where canal users had to pay a toll fee to cross from Birmingham Canal to the Stratford/ Worcester Canal. From here the tour will continue up the main line heading toward Selly Oak until we reach The Vale, the backyard of Birmingham University. Immerse yourself in the beauty of the rural countryside before we make our way back to the ICC.

Canal boat tour start time	13:00	Cruising along on a summer's day in Birmingham, seeing sights of the city that you have never seen before.
Afternoon cream tea serving time	13:15	A selection of sandwiches served on white and brown bread, fruit scones with preserve and whip cream. A selection of fresh cream pastries and fresh strawberries and cream. Tea or coffee also served with a sweet biscuit.
