Largest regional economy outside London



109,000 businesses and a GVA of over £69 billion



Skilled workforce of 1.4 million people




Nine universities (largest cluster outside London) producing 39,000 graduates per year. Over 15,000 in STEM subjects, the highest outside of London



The cost of starting a business is 80% lower than London

A cluster of 250 medical device companies - the largest in the UK – and 65 of which are dedicated digital health companies




22% of all UK digital health technology jobs

3 Incubator and research gateway hubs, plus a wealth of investment, accelerator and support programmes



Yorkshire and the Humber- Health



Breadth and depth of health and life sciences innovation infrastructure, connectivity, and of centres of excellence



MedTech accounts for 62% of all life sciences employment in Yorkshire and the Humber (the highest proportion in the UK)



Yorkshire and Humber is the UK's second highest region for MedTech employment



Between 2011 and 2020, over 1.700 new private sector jobs were created in the region's life sciences sector

Our Impact

As a result of our work between 2018 and 2020, we estimate that at least:



103,000 patients benefitted from better, safer care

Additionally, in 2020-21, we estimate that:



£5.3m of new healthcare investment was brought to our region



£72m was saved by the healthcare system



1,500 patients were able to self-monitor their COVID symptoms with pulse oximeters



526 innovator companies received out support



£1.8m of maternity bed days were avoided through our PIGF testing programme
