PRACTICAL INFORMATION

Dates

The 37th World Conference will take place over five days from Tuesday 27 July to Saturday 31 July 2021. Further details of the programme and session timings can be found later in this document.

Conference Platform

We are excited to introduce to you the conference platform where World Conference information and activities will take place.

You will be able to access the platform at the beginning of July. An email will be sent to all the registered World Conference participants with the login credentials.

The first time you log into the platform, it will ask you for permission to use the microphone and the camera. It will also check your internet connection speed and adapt the platform settings to make sure you can fully participate.

On this platform, you will find:

- Document library with all the conference documents in all languages
- Programme of the conference: you can join the plenary sessions in this space
- All the registered participants: talk to fellow participants and schedule meetings
- Exhibition space (with candidates' information, bidding countries, Motion 32...): check all the information, talk to them, and schedule meetings

We will show you how to navigate the platform during the orientation session and all the participants will receive more information about the platform in the next conference circular on 30 June 2021.

During the World Conference week, we will have a technical team ready to help any participant with technological problems.

What you will need

- A strong Wi-Fi or data connection
- A device (laptop/tablet/smartphone) with speakers and a microphone. If you want the other participants to see you, the device should also have a camera
- A headset or headphones will make it easier to speak and listen to other participants
- A setting where it is reasonably quiet – to make it easier to capture all the information
- A pen and paper – if you want to make notes during the sessions

At the World Conference, we welcome our friends from all over the world. This means that many people will be speaking and working in their second, third, or fourth language. We ask everybody to make an effort to speak clearly and slowly.

ORIENTATION SESSIONS

Saturday 3 and Sunday 4 July 2021

We are offering a number of orientation sessions for Member Organisations. These would normally take place the day before World Conference officially begins, as everyone arrives at the conference venue. Because of the online format this time, and the different way the World Conference will be run, we are offering the orientation sessions more than three weeks before the conference begins. This is to help us all become comfortable with using and navigating around the conference platform, and understand how things will work during conference week. It will also help us to identify any technical challenges so these can be addressed before the conference. The orientation sessions will cover a run through of the programme, a summary of the World Conference Rules of Procedure, a voting test, and housekeeping arrangements.

BIDS TO HOST THE 38TH WORLD CONFERENCE

Four Member Organisations are bidding to host the 38th World Conference which will take place in 2023:

Head delegates will be asked to vote on their preferred bid on day five of the conference, Saturday 31 July.



WHAT SHOULD I DO TO PREPARE?

- ✔ Ensure that you have read the relevant Conference documents and discussed these within your national associations and networks.
- ✔ If you are considering proposing an amendment to a Non-Constitutional Motion, or a new Proposed Non-Constitutional Motion we strongly recommend discussing this with the Procedural Team as soon as possible. Due to the limited amount of time in plenary sessions at this World Conference we encourage Member Organisations to give careful consideration before submitting a new Proposed Motion or Proposed Amendment. The deadline for any proposed amendments to non-constitutional motions, or new proposed motions is 3 pm UTC on Tuesday 27 July. You can contact the Procedural Team at proceduralteam@waggs.org
- ✔ Log in and explore the conference platform before the orientation session, Saturday 3 or Sunday 4 July.
- ✔ Attend the orientation session and, if you are a Head Delegate, participate during the voting test.
- ✔ Attend the discussion sessions about proposed motions and proposed amendments happening in June.
- ✔ Schedule meetings with other conference participants, meet the candidates, and ask questions to the bidding countries. You will be able to do all of this after the orientation sessions.
- ✔ If you are a young woman under 30, you are welcome to attend the Young Women's pre-event (more information above)
- ✔ Sign up to present a song, poem, skit/play, or story during the Campfire (more information below).
- ✔ During the World Conference, there will be an "in memorium" reflection. Please, send us an email to woco@waggs.org if you would like anyone to be remembered.

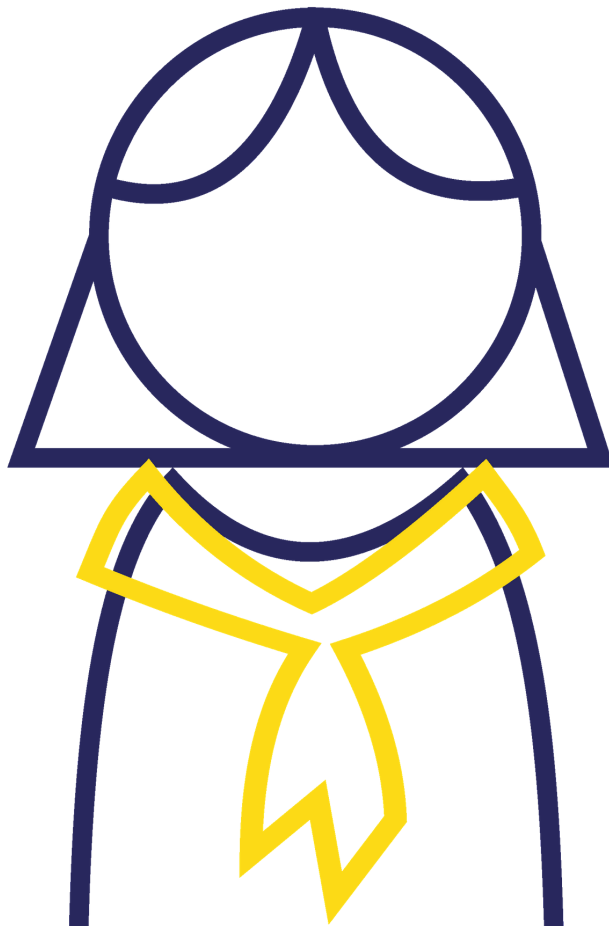

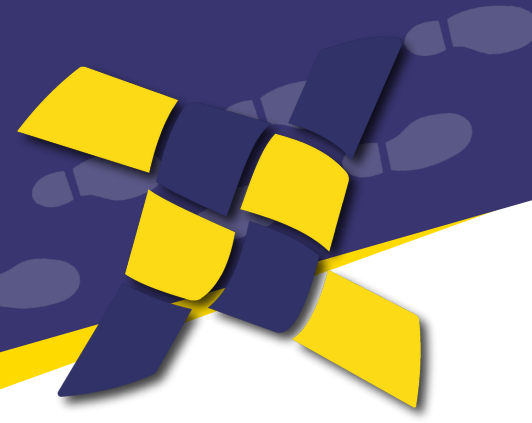

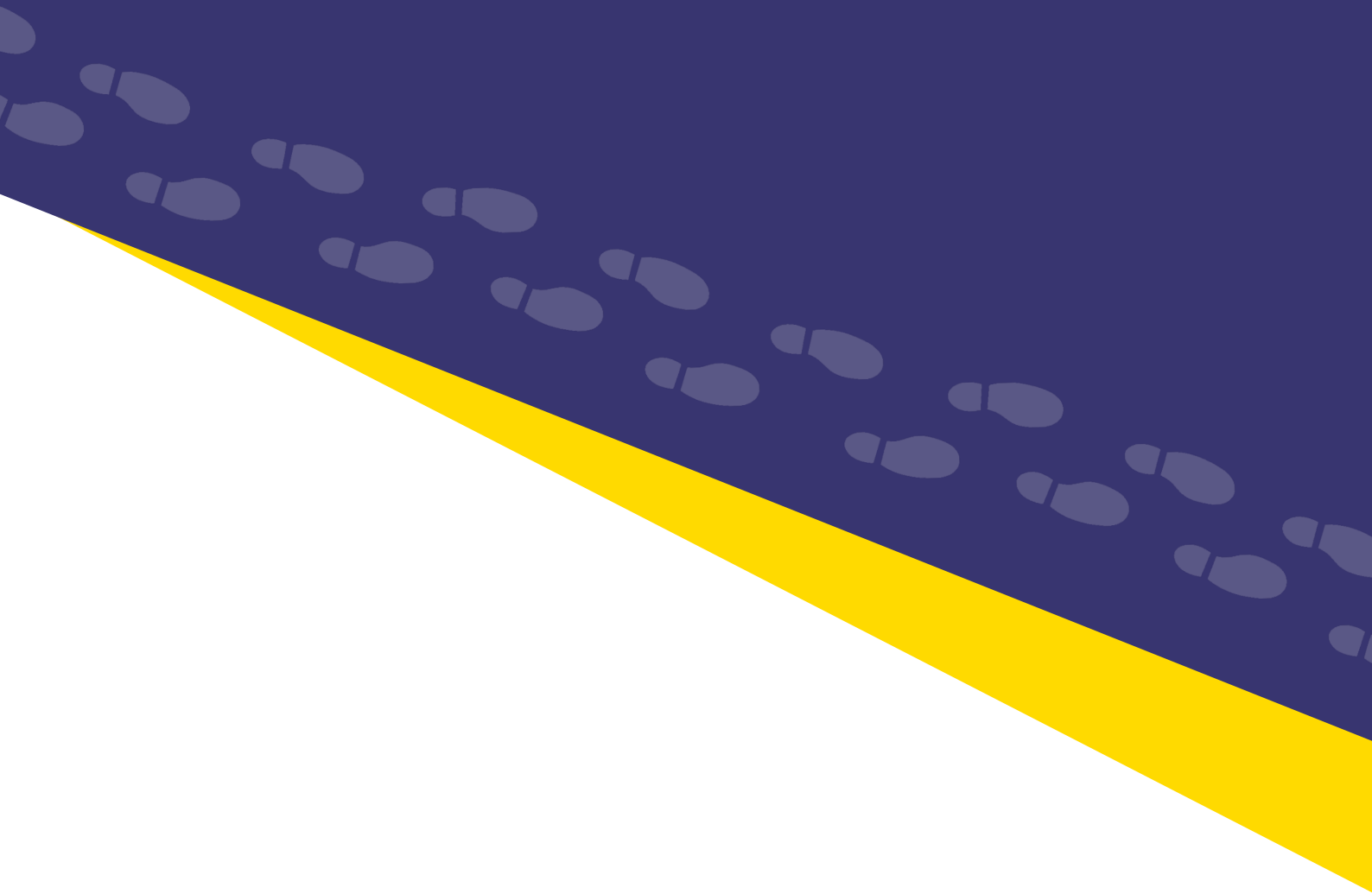
